Italy


- For the last 10 years the value of norwegianseafood exports has increased by 122%;
- Increase of 15% in terms of value and volume;
- The consumption of norwegian salmon is constantly increasing in italy;



- Main Turkish import items from Norway are salmons, petroleum, gas and ferro-alloys.
- Main Turkish export items to Norway are fishing vessels, boats, containers for the transport and holding seafoods.

- Problems
 - Sea lice
 - Scapes from aquaculture farms

- Goals
 - Increase consumption of seafood
 - Eradicate hunger
 - Sustainable growth



Solutions

- Sea lice
 - Place farms in locations where contact with wild fish is minimised
 - Vaccines
 - Closed systems
- Solutions for aquaculture farms
 - Technologies informing control center
 - Robots checking nets
 - Sensors in the nets (intelligent nets)

Increase consumption of seafood

- Advertise to raise awareness
- Reduce the price of seafood in supermarkets
- Cooking lessons in schools
- More protective areas less polution more/healthier fish Hunt more profitable. — Prices decrease

Making aquaculture sustainable

- Fossil fuels. Wind or solar energy (usage of wave energy)
- Grow their own seaweed
- Fish feces fertilize seaweed
- Reduce waste in fish production
- Introduce powersaving measures
