WHAT IS AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT IN TURKEY?

An international student is somebody who:

- Who is foreign,
- Who was born Turkish but has left Turkish citizenship,
- Who was born in a different nationality but obtained Turkish citizenship later,
- Turkish citizens who have completed their high school education in a country other than Turkey,
- Citizens of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus who completed all of their high school education in Northern Cyprus and hold GCE-AL examination results or have completed high school in a different country.

HOW TO BECOME AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

Every university has a different application process and a different calendar.

Applications can be taken by:

- a) High School Diploma GPA
- b) Entrance examination for International Students (YÖS)

Applications are normally taken online

YÖS EXAMINATIONS

Some universities have their own YÖS examination and accept only the results of their university YÖS examination.

Some universities have their own YÖS examinations and accept YÖS examination results from other university YÖS examinations.

Some universities do not have a YÖS examination but accept YÖS examination results from other university YÖS examinations.

DETAILS OF YÖS EXAMINATIONS

Some universities have an examination only on their own campus.

Some universities have examinations on their own campus and other cities in Turkey.

Some universities have examinations in many different countries.

One university has an on-line YÖS examination.

YÖS examinations generally consist of mathematics, geometry and general logic problems.

Some universities have an extra Turkish language examination.

YÖS examinations generally have an application fee associated with them (this varies according to the university)

HOW TO APPLY AS AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

Follow the website of the university you want to apply to

There will be an announcement of the application dates and documents required for application

If there is an examination fee, you will need to pay it

Upload your documents on to the application system

Download your examination entrance document

Take the YÖS examination

Wait for the results

If you have a place, register at the required time and place.





APPLICATIONS TO AYDIN ADNAN MENDERES UNIVERSITY

- Applications for Associate and Bachelor Degrees will be taken in March or April 2019.
- Applications will be taken online.

ADÜ APPLICATION PROCESS

ADÜ has an online application system and an online YÖS exam:

Step 1- Create a user account

Step 2- Enter the ADÜ Application System

Step 3 – Complete the required data about your personal details and high school education

Step 4 - Pay the ADÜYÖS examination fee
- 200 Turkish Lira or 50 US Dollars or 45 Euros

Step 5 – Re-enter the ADÜYÖS application system and upload your documents and bank slip.

Step 6 – Submit your application

N.B.: The language you apply with will be the language your exam occurs in (Turkish or English) (You can change the language at: "My Settings" > "Password / Language Operations" > "Language".

UPLOADING OF DOCUMENTS TO ADÜYÖS APPLICATON SYSTEM


Documents to be uploaded:

- 1) High school diploma or temporary graduation document or a student certificate for those in the final year of high school,
- 2) Transcript of records,
- 3) Passport page showing personal information or official document showing citizenship with a photograph. In Turkish or English or Turkish Translation.
- 4) Bank receipt showing your name and surname, (of 200 Turkish Liras, 50 US Dollars or 45 Euro),
- 5) A passport photograph taken within the last year
- 6) Document showing your Turkish Identity Number (TC Number) (Turkish Identity Card, Residence Permission Card or similar) (if available),
- 7) Document showing examination results (if available).

- ADÜYÖS exam is online
- Everybody must take the ADÜYÖS examination.
- You will need a reliable internet connection, a webcam and a computer.
- You can use a pen and paper during the examination.
- You cannot use mobile phones and calculators during the examination.

- Online ADÜYÖS examination consists of 50 questions.
- The examination period is 80 minutes.
- The questions will be from mathematics, geometry, mathematical logic and reasoning.
- The examination will be evaluated from 100 points.
- It is possible to skip a question.

REGISTRATION DATES

Principle candidates - End of July, 2019

Need to register

- With the necessary documents
- in person
- without payment of academic fees
- to the International students office, Rectorate Building

Additional Placement should be carried out in August 2019.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR REGISTRATION

- a) Original High School Diploma or graduation document and 'Equivalency Document' of this diploma or graduation document from a Turkish Embassy or Consulate in the student's own country or from the Provincial Directorate of National Education, certifying the equivalency of the applicant's diploma to that of Turkish diplomas,
- b) Original transcript of records and its notarized Turkish translation,
- c) Original passport and its notarised Turkish translation,
- d) Bank receipt showing payment of the student's tuition fee into the relevant bank account (after pre-registration at ADÜ)
- e) 6 passport-size photographs (4.5cm x 6cm) taken within the last 12 months.
- f) For departments with Turkish education, a Turkish Language Proficiency Level Certificate accepted by ADÜ TÖMER; for departments with English education, an English Language Proficiency Level Certificate accepted by ADÜ School of Foreign Languages; for departments with French education, a French Language Proficiency Level Certificate accepted by ADÜ School of Foreign Languages; for departments with German education, a German Language Proficiency Level Certificate accepted by ADÜ School of Foreign Languages (if available).
- g) Original examination results documents (SAT, YÖS result etc. if available).
- h) 'Vukuatlı Nüfus Kayıt Örneği' (Certificate of Identity Register Copy) for students who have double nationality-one of which is Turkish.
- i) Health Report taken from a general state hospital in Turkey for students to study at the Faculty of Medicine, Nursing, Midwifery, First Aid.
- Important: Translations which have been approved by notaries from countries other than Turkey must be carry the Apostil stamp.

LANGUAGE ISSUES

COURSES IN ENGLISH

 Programmes in Engineering (Computer, Civil, Electric-Electronic, Food, Mechanical Engineering)

International Relations (on Aydın Main campus)

- English Language and Literature, French Language and Literature, German Language and Literature. (These have some translation courses – Students need Turkish and the foreign language).
- Faculty of Education, English Language Teaching

All other courses are in Turkish.

English/French/German courses have English/French/German Preparatory year. Turkish Courses have Turkish Preparatory year.

TÖMER

TÖMER is a language centre for learning Turkish. There are many centres in Turkey.

Also the Yunus Emre Institute – has centres in Turkey and 56 centres around the world.

ADÜTÖMER runs Turkish courses throughout the academic year starting from A1 level until C1.

There are 6 levels and each level is 1000 Turkish liras for students who are not registered at this university.
